

19th Edition UTAH 1088

One of the many traditions of fall is the opening of registration for the annual UTAH 1088 rally, and fortunately this fall is following in that tradition. MERA is proud to announce the 19th running of the UTAH 1088. And while we are honoring our tradition by opening registration on October 1, 2009, we will be starting new traditions with some new innovations that we will be introducing at this year's rally.

Registration officially opens October 1, 2009, and will remain open until the field of 75 riders is full. At that time, we will start a stand-by list for riders that are waiting to enter the rally. This list will be called if and when riders who are already entered in the rally are forced to withdraw for one reason or another.

The 2010 edition of the UTAH 1088 will be held from June 25, 2010 through June 27, 2010. Our annual pre-rally BBQ will be held on June 24, 2010.

In our long and storied history we have developed the reputation of being one of the premier rallies in the country. The 2010 edition will certainly be no different, and will test veteran and novice alike. And we will do our utmost to offer you a rally experience that you will never forget.

Entry fees for 2010 will remain at the same level as 2009, \$250.00 for single riders, and \$300.00 for couples. MERA members may of course deduct 10% from the published entry fees. Your entry fee not only gets you into this incredible event, but it also gets you into the pre rally Bar B Q, your rally shirt, water bottle, hat, post rally banquet, and a chance for a goodly number of quality door prizes.

We will once again offer Ironbutt Association SaddleSore 1000 certificates for those riders that earn them during the rally. All expenses and paperwork will be handled by us in your behalf. . .all you'll need to do is ride the correct amount of miles.

The 2010 rally will return to our original format of 24 hours. The route that I have envisioned should allow riders every opportunity to experience the beauty of this great state, and possibly even a little of the surrounding states as well. And as has been our habit, we will offer multiple routes for your riding pleasure. These routes will vary in difficulty and point value. For those riders that are interested in pushing the envelope just a bit further, well I can assure you that there will be sufficient bonus locations for you in your quest for fame and glory.

We will once again allow riders to use digital camera, but riders can still use Polaroid cameras if they prefer for bonus verification. GPS units, and auxiliary fuel cells are allowed, but not required.

Finisher's awards will be given to all riders that finish the rally in the allotted time, and travel at least the minimum main route distance. Position plaques will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in the single rider class, and the top 3 in the couple's class.

Rally packs will be mailed out on or before February 1, 2010, and will contain the complete schedule of the rally, a brief overview of the rally, complete rules, and all hotel information. For those of you that attended the 2009 1088, you will be glad to know that we will be returning to the same hotel. I know it's hard to believe, after three different rallies they still want us back, but they do.

The refund deadline is March 1, 2010, and all refunds will be charged a \$50.00 handling/aggravation fee.

The UTAH 1088 has always been an event for both veterans rally riders, and novice's alike. It doesn't matter what you ride. . .where you ride. . .or how long you've been riding. If you've been thinking about riding an endurance event, then the UTAH 1088 is the event you want to enter. The 1088 will challenge you from the starting line to the finish line. But it will also offer you one of the most memorable and rewarding experiences that you've ever had on a motorcycle. We give you the opportunity to ride some of the best roads and experience some of the most beautiful scenery this country has to offer. And the camaraderie that you will experience at this event is like nothing you will experience in any other rally. So if you go home without having fun, well, it's your own fault.

We have quite a history here at the 1088, for it is truly like no other event in the country. And we hope that you'll decide to join us in our 19th year and write your own chapter or two in that history.
